ADMINISTRATIVE RESOLUTION NO. 2021-002

AN ADMINISTRATIVE RATE RESOLUTION OF THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF SAN BUENAVENTURA, CALIFORNIA, PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 2016-007 BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN BUENAVENTURA AND E. J. HARRISON & SONS, INC., FOR AJDUSTMENTS TO SERVICE RATES FOR THE COLLECTION, SWEEPING, DIVERSION, AND DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE, AND COLLECTION AND TRANSPORT FOR PROCESSING OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS AND ORGANIC WASTE

WHEREAS, On June 9, 2020, the City requested the deferral of the implementation of tipping fee pass-through rate adjustments from July 1, 2020 to January 1, 2021, due to the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic; and,

WHEREAS, The lost revenue to Harrison due to the deferral of the of the tipping fee pass-through rate adjustment was incorporated into the January 1, 2021, rates approved by the City; and,

WHEREAS, The retroactive portion of that rate will be removed from rates on September 1, 2021, resulting in a \$.47 per month reduction for the 64-gallon cart residential base rate and a \$2.86 per month reduction for the commercial base rate; and.

WHEREAS, On June 9, 2021, Gold Recycling requested a pass-through tipping fees increase, effective September 1, 2021, due to an increase in tipping fees at its designated disposal facility, Toland Landfill; and

WHEREAS, On July 12, 2021, City staff reviewed and approved all the documentation submitted by Harrison to justify the pass-through rate adjustment due to the Gold Coast tipping fee increase; and,

WHEREAS, The pass-through tipping fee increase will result in a \$.07 per month increase for 64-gallon cart residential base rate and a \$.38 per month increase for the commercial base rate; and,

WHEREAS, The retroactive credit of \$.47 minus the \$.07 pass-through tipping fee increase will result in a \$.40 decrease for the 64-gallon cart residential base rate and the retroactive credit of \$2.86 per month minus the \$.38 per month pass-through tipping fee increase will result in a \$2.48 decrease for the commercial base rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Manager of the City of San Buenaventura does hereby resolve, determine, and order as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: Beginning September 1, 2021, and continuing until changes in rates are made pursuant to the Franchise Agreement, the monthly residential rates that may be charged for refuse collection once per week shall be as follows:

34	gallon capacity	\$29.64
64	gallon capacity	\$32.63
101	gallon capacity	\$37.59

All service levels include recycling and green waste service. The monthly rates for condominium complexes, mobile home parks and other residential clusters of greater than four units, where container service is provided and only a single billing is required for the total residential cluster, shall be \$1.00 less than that charged for equivalent residential rates.

Condominiums, planned unit developments, and homeowner's associations which have individual barrel service, and which are exempted from green waste service, shall be credited \$2.78 per unit per month.

Section 2: <u>Miscellaneous Residential Service Rates</u>. Beginning September 1, 2021, and continuing until changes in rates are made pursuant to the Franchise Ordinance, the monthly residential rates that may be charged for solid waste collection once per week shall be as follows:

Failure to participate in the "Unicycling Program" or segregated recycling container (white bin) recycling program (applies to all commercial and multi-family accounts that use yard bins described in the rate schedule above) will result in a 25% surcharge fee on the entire bill.

Generators with a waste stream rich in recyclable material that are unwilling to divert over 25% of their recyclable materials by volume shall be charged a 25% surcharge fee on the entire bill.

Section 5: <u>Drop Box (Roll-off) Service Rates.</u> Beginning September 1, 2021, and continuing until changes in rates are made pursuant to the Franchise Ordinance, industrial rates for Drop Box service that may be charged for solid waste and/or source separated recyclable material collection shall be as follows:

The **processing fee** is charged by Gold Coast Recycling on all Drop Boxes if not source-separated. The **show-up charge** may be issued if the Hauler is unable to collect a Drop Box due to customer error, when requested by customer. The **overweight charge** may be issued if any Drop Box is loaded over 10 tons, in addition to disposal costs. The **round-trip charge** may be issued if customers require a special service to return the same box to the customer round-trip.

Drop Box rental does not apply to boxes delivered to customers with continuing drop box service who have at least three pick-ups per month.

Customers requiring special service to pick up and deliver roll-off box, special access problems, etc. Rate for additional service set by the Hauler.

<u>Section 6</u>: <u>Rental Bin Service</u>. Beginning September 1, 2021, and continuing until changes in rates are made pursuant to the Franchise Ordinance, the rates that may be charged for rental bin service shall be as follows:

Delivery, pick-up, and disposal: \$100.03 Bin rental, starting the 7th day (following the day of delivery): \$3.00/day Section 7: Bulky Item Service Rates. Beginning September 1, 2021, and continuing until changes in rates are made pursuant to the Franchise Ordinance, the rates that may be charged for rental bin service shall be as follows:
